LINE UP ACTIVITY

(this activity was created by GSA (Gay/Straight/Alliance) students in Hawaii's schools)

Depending on the room size:

The whole group can line up in two equal lines facing each other or you can have the group form a circle with everyone facing each other. A facilitator will read each question, allowing time for individuals to respond to the question with either stepping forward or standing still.

QUESTIONS

STEP FORWARD IF YOU.....

Are from Hawaii

Are not from Hawaii or US (United States)

Are from US (united States)

You have a family member or friend that is LGBT (Lesbian/Gay/Bisexual/Transgender)

You have children who identify as LGBT

You were ever bullied in school: elementary, middle or high

You have witnessed anti-LGBT bullying or harassment

You have experienced or seen bullying in a classroom while a teacher was present and no one did or said anything

Experienced a teacher stop class just to talk about the problems or definitions of LGBT people.

Have any teachers that are LGBT or openly support LGBT

You have seen a LGBT person being bullied

You've met someone who is LGBT

You've made friends with someone who is LGBT

You've assumed a person is LGBT because of their appearance or personality If you have bullied a LGBT person

You have used LGBT slurs such as "dyke", "tranny", "faggot"

If you have been called "gay", "faggot" "dyke" or "tranny" as an insult in school Are openly LGBTQIAP (lesbian,gay,bi-sexual, transgender, questioning, Intersex, asexual, pan-sexual)

You've gone to a church and they have preached about how being LGBT is wrong You've ever thought of suicide because not having support from others Know someone who has committed suicide because they were bullied Know some one who has committed suicide because of their struggle with their sexuality or gender identity.
