Program Duration

Trainees: Mid May - March 31, 2023

Eligibility

- Students or professionals who are from American Samoa or the Commonwealth of Northern Marianas Islands.
- Trainees - must have completed at least 1 year of Community College and have at least B or higher in English 100.

- 3 college credits from the University of Hawaii at Mānoa. (Approximately \$1,500 value)
- Opportunity for professional development and access to conferences and resources.
- Stipends for participating in some activities.
- Certificate as a UCEDD trainee.
